Can someone provide me with a definitive answer on whether ERCOT requires Load Serving Entities (LSEs) or other providers to have a Reserve Capacity Margin? If so, can you tell me when that rule was set in place and if not, when the rule make have changed?

It is my understanding that ERCOT itself has a rule that it must maintain a 13.75% reserve but I am trying to verify whether a similar policy exists (or existed) for LSEs. Specifically between 2007 and 2017.
